

Student Protocol for Live Lessons

- High standards of behaviour are expected during on line lessons as they are in school.
- Lessons will be recorded.
- Students will not share lesson invites, students struggling to login to the lesson should contact the teacher directly.
- Students will only be admitted to the lesson by the teacher via the lobby.
- Your camera and microphone should be turned off and muted until instructed otherwise by the class teacher.
- Only use the chat box when instructed by the teacher.
- The chat box can only be used for comments relating to the lesson.
- Use of defamatory, prejudice and/or racist language is unacceptable on any level and will be reported by the class teacher to a Deputy Head Teacher.
- All participants will wear suitable dress.
- If your camera is turned on you should ensure personal information and/or inappropriate or unsuitable personal items are not visible.
- Where possible, other household members should not be in the background or shot; if this unavoidable, they should follow appropriate language and behaviour expectations.
- Staff will mute and/or disable learners' microphones and camera if a student fails to comply with the protocol.
