Dear Parents,

Further to Mr Collins letter dated Tuesday 12 May, we now need to establish whether you wish your son/daughter to take up the offer of some face to face contact in school from 1 June. We understand that the last few months have been very difficult for everyone, both in terms of emotional well-being and academic progress, and so many will welcome the opportunity to return to school. However, in the interest of transparency we need to make you aware of the following factors as you make your decision for your child:

- It is unlikely that there will be any school buses running
- There is no PPE provided, although students could bring their own
- Students will be designated a singular room and staff will come to them
- Students will be in school for one day a week and so we will not be able to offer their full timetable
- Students will be in school with students from their band (V, W, X, XA), so we cannot guarantee they will be with their friends
- They will have an hour each with an English, maths and science specialist, but this may not be their normal class teacher
- They will have an hour long session of self-supported study on their options subjects, but this may not be supervised by their actual subject teacher
- They will have a short lunch break, for which they will need to bring a packed lunch, as there will be no catering available onsite
